Housing Options

Domestic / Family Violence Shelter

- Self contained units for women and children escaping domestic and family violence:
 - two 3-bedroom units
 - four 2-bedroom units
 - including one disability-accessible unit
- Safety and security at a confidential address.
- 7 day, 24 hour service. Residents are contactable by an on-call worker after hours in emergencies.

General Accommodation

- Seven houses in the community for families including one disability-accessible duplex.
- Eight 2-bedroom units for single women, families and parents who have contact with their children.
- One transitional house providing longer term support for families moving on from crisis housing.

All housing is fully furnished



Services Provided

Using a trauma-informed and recovery-based framework to provide:

Crisis Accommodation and Support

- Case management support to assist you to plan and achieve your goals.
- Tenancy education.
- Support to access specialist services. eg health, legal, counselling, parenting, relationships.
- Budgeting support and referral to specialist financial counselling services.
- Crisis and domestic / family violence counselling.
- Programs aimed at developing parenting and life skills.
- Trauma-informed group work for both adults and children.
- Assistance in establishing/maintaining an income.
- Information and advocacy.
- Access to training, employment, and education.

Emergency Relief

- We respond to the material aid requirements of people in the Nambour Centrelink area.
- Our focus is on sustaining tenancies, providing early intervention support to prevent homelessness, and information and advocacy.

Better Start Program

- A long term innovative in-home visiting program for people moving on from crisis.
